Catherine was a life-long learner and enjoyed writing poetry, and especially playing bridge. Catherine is survived by her husband of 61 years, Donald B Smith. She is the mother of three children: Stephen M. Smith (Carla) – Little Falls, NY; Diane S. Chu (Donald) – Laurel, MD; and Sheila S. Morrell (Douglas) – Long Valley, NJ. She has 5 adoring grandchildren that she happily doted over: Andrew Smith (Jamie), Alessandra S. Miller (Ben), Philip Chu, Joan Chu and Judy Morrell. She is also survived by her brother, James Dellea (Pittsfield, MA) and sister, Joan DeKimpe (Claverack, NY).
