



Mr. Carmen D. Trivisonno

February 2, 1945 - September 2, 2022

Carmen D. Trivisonno, of Tully, NY passed away at his home, with his family present, on September 2, 2022 after a lengthy illness. Carmen's love for his family was the priority in his life. He was well known for his sense of humor, charisma, and storytelling ability.

Born February 2, 1945 in Cortland, NY, Carmen was the son of Dominick and Filomena Fantacone Trivisonno. He graduated from Cortland High School in 1963 and SUNY Morrisville in 1965. He went on to faithfully serve his country in Vietnam with the United States Marine Corps until 1967.

In 1972, Carmen received his degree in Physical Therapy from the University of Buffalo. He was the Director of Physical Therapy at Community General Hospital and proprietor of Cortland Physical Therapy and Sports Rehabilitation. He was a communicant of St. Anthony of Padua Roman Catholic Church.

Survivors include his wife, Linda Sciaruto Trivisonno; two daughters, Carly Trivisonno and Capri (Colin) Potter; brother, Angelo "Chubby" (Yvonne) Trivisonno; two sisters, Libby Granato and Philomena Trivisonno; mother-in-law, Francesca Sciaruto; as well as many nieces, nephews, cousins, and brother- and sister-in-laws. In addition to his parents, Carmen was predeceased by his brother and sister-in-law, Peter and Dora Trivisonno;

brother-in-law, Robert Granato; and father-in-law, Pietro Sciaruto.

The family will be present to receive family and friends on Friday, September 9, 2022 from 5-8 pm at St. Anthony of Padua Roman Catholic Church, 50 Pomeroy St., Cortland, NY. A Christian Mass will be celebrated on Saturday, September 10, 2022 at 10:30 am at St. Anthony's Church.
