



Mr. Francis J. Snyder

August 1, 1920 - November 5, 2013

Francis J. "Fritz" Snyder, 93, of Cortland, passed away on Tuesday, November 5, 2013 at Cortland Regional Medical Center Residential Care Facility. He was born August 1, 1920 the son of Fredrick and Minnie O'Mara Snyder and was a Cortland resident most of his life.

Fritz graduated from St. Mary's High School in 1938, married Loretta Agnes Ryan in 1948 and retired from NCC Industries in 1982 as the supervisor of the cutting department. Fritz had been employed by Crescent Corset and NCC for 44 years. He was a communicant of St. Mary's Church in Cortland for most of his life, attending St. Leo's Parish in Tully when he and Loretta lived in Tully. Fritz enjoyed his family more than anything. He also enjoyed hunting, fishing, taking long walks and golfing at Willowbrook.
