Genoveffa Tullio Cimini, of Cortland, N.Y. passed away, Monday, February 10, 2014 at the Cortland Park Rehabilitation & Nursing Center at the age of 107. Born, January 19, 1907 in Ernest, Pennsylvania, Genoveffa was the daughter of Emidio and Rosaria Gallucci Tullio.
