Glen Cary Clarke, 70 years old, born March 17, 1954, died August 20, 2024 after a brave battle with small cell lung cancer. He is survived by his loving wife of 44 years, Carol Guingo Clarke and by his sister Mary (Frank) Alverson, his sister-in-law Joan Clarke and brothers Milo Clarke, Ted (Kumiko) Clarke, and Richard (Yuki) Clarke, along with several nieces and nephews.

He was an avid reader, a seeker of knowledge, and had an extensive collection of books ranging across many genres. He also enjoyed solving puzzles of any kind. His favorite teams were the NY Yankees and the NY Giants. Additionally, Glen and Carol traveled extensively throughout the decades, visiting all 50 U.S. States and many other International destinations.
