John L. "Lenny" Dwyer, 81, of Truxton, N.Y. passed away, on Sunday, March 17, 2013. Born, April 25, 1931 in Apulia Station, Lenny was a Truxton resident for most of his life.

He faithfully served his country from 1952-1954 in the Korean Conflict and was employed at Cashel Trucking and Cortland Ready Mix for over 38 years, and for a time with the New York State Highway Department. Lenny was a communicant of St. Patrick's Roman Catholic Church in Truxton and a 67 year member of the Truxton Fire Department and served as Fire Chief for 11 of those years.
