Mr. Malcolm “Mac” E. Gilbert, 80, of McGraw, N.Y. passed away on Thursday February 7, 2019 at University Hospital, Syracuse, N.Y. after a lengthy illness. Born October 13, 1938 in Cortland the son of Marian and Agnes Nichols Gilbert, Mac was a McGraw resident for most of his life.

Mac had retired from Seneca Supply Co. in Ithaca where he was employed for many years as the parts manager. He enjoyed golf and his membership with the McGraw Lions Club. He was also a two term member of the McGraw School Board and Booster Club. Although raised in another faith, Mac converted to Catholicism and was an active and loyal communicant of St. Mary’s Roman Catholic Church.
