It is with heavy hearts that we share the loss of Patrick S. Mazzone on June 23, 2025. Pat, as he was known, was a kind and caring person who struggled with addiction more than half his life. Our fear was that we would lose him to an overdose, but that was not the case. The good Lord had a plan for him because he kept him safe many times, but the years of struggle eventually took a toll on his body and that was a battle he did not win.

Pat was born April 4, 1982 (Palm Sunday), to Joanne Moses Sweeney and Paul Mazzone. He was predeceased by his maternal grandparents, Vernon and Irene Moses and paternal grandparents Alfred and Martha Mazzone, along with many dear friends who lost their battles with addiction. He's survived by his parents, Joanne (Matthew) Sweeney of Homer and Paul (Nancy) Mazzone of North Carolina; his sister, Jill Mazzone (David Manning) and nephew, Connor Freeman, of Virginia; his half brother, Nick Mazzone of North Carolina; and many other aunts, uncles, cousins, and dear friends who are like family.

Patrick attended school at Homer Central Schools, receiving his GED his senior year, 2001. He was a talented cook, working for many establishments in the Cortland and Homer area and also in Arizona. People knew and loved Pat for his smile, kind and caring heart, work ethic, and sense of humor.

The family wishes to thank everyone who tried to help him over the years and who have supported us on this long journey. We would also like to give special thanks to the amazing and compassionate staff at the University of Miami Hospital.

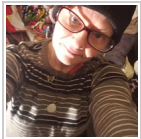
