Mr. Remo G. DeStefano, 94, of Cortland passed away, Tuesday January 5, 2016 at University Hospital in Syracuse, N.Y. Born September 3, 1921 in Italy, Remo came to Cortland from Italy in 1956 and served in the Italian Army during World War II.
