Richard Gregory Platt, 72, of Cortland, New York passed away peacefully Tuesday February 25, 2020 at the Guthrie Cortland Medical Center after a year-long battle of cancer with his family by his side. He was born July 28, 1947 in Syracuse, New York to Richard W. Platt and Mary (Brennan) Platt.
