Rosalie "Rose" Josephine Ciarlariello DeCenzo of Cortland, N.Y., passed away Saturday, March 29, 2014 at the Cortland Park Rehabilitation & Nursing Center at the age of 96. Born August 23, 1917, in Cortland, Rose was the daughter of Domenick and Coronata "Laura" Romano Ciarlariello of Campobasso, Italy. At the age of 16, Rose began work at the Cortland Line Company, then at Wilson Tennis Racquets in Cortland. After the birth of her daughters, Rose was hired by Brewer Tichner where she worked for 23 years. She retired from SUNY Cortland in 1984 after spending several years as part of the custodial staff. Rose also owned and operated several gift shops through the years, most recently Rosie's Red Barn on Port Watson St. Rose was a lifelong communicant of St. Anthony of Padua Roman Catholic Church. She loved to travel, dance, read, cook for her family, and play with her great-grandchildren.
