Ms. Sofia M. Salce, 70, of Cortland, passed away on Sunday, March 29, 2026 at University Hospital, Syracuse.

Born June 20, 1955 in Cortland, Sofia was a daughter of Ricky and Mary Fumarola Salce and had been a Cortland resident her entire life.

Sofia was a communicant of St. Mary's Catholic Church and was recently employed at Cayuga Orthopedics in Cortland.
