Thomas James Wilkins, 64, of 67 Church St, Cortland, N.Y. passed away December 27, 2014 after a short illness. His most important passion was spending time with his family. He loved taking trips to Vegas, Atlantic City, the Outer Banks, N. Carolina and visiting his grandchildren Ben and Ella in Maryland. Most recently he enjoyed his outings with his brothers in law, including their weekly breakfasts.

Tom is survived by his high school sweetheart, Judi of 41 years, son, Tyler and daughter, Rebecca (Aaron) Sprouse and grandchildren, Benjamin and Ella; his brother, Robert (Mitzi) Wilkins and aunts, uncles and cousins. He is also survived by his sisters in law; Cheryl (Peter) Contento and Kathy (Gerald) Coggi and several nieces and nephews.
